SCHOOL SHIELD POINT SYSTEM

Two School Shields will be awarded upon the completion of judging of all Junior Classes in School Subjects, Junior Art and Junior Home Cooking. The *Talinga Office Supplies Shield* (est. 1974) will be awarded to the High School, while the *Printers & Stationers Shield* (est. 1975) will be awarded to the Primary School with the highest point score upon the completion of judging of all classes.

Points are awarded per class, as follows:

- 1st Place – 3 points
- 2nd Place – 2 points
- 3rd Place – 1 point

No points are awarded on entry of exhibit. Only placing exhibits contribute to the School Shields Point Score. The Judges decisions are final.

SPECIAL NOTES FOR SCHOOLS: THIS NOTE ONLY APPLIES TO JUNIOR COOKING

- By arrangement goods can be collected at a time suitable to the School.
- Reimbursement of School costs to supply paper plates & plastic bags for entering home cooking exhibits can be organised upon supply of receipts with the Show Accounts Department.
